An Act

To designate the United States Courthouse located at 156 Federal Street in Portland, Maine, as the "Edward Thaxter Gignoux United States Courthouse".

July 19, 1988

[S. 2248]

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF BUILDING.**

The United States Courthouse located at 156 Federal Street in Portland, Maine, shall be known and is designated as the "Edward Thaxter Gignoux United States Courthouse".

**SEC. 2. LEGAL REFERENCES TO BUILDING.**

Any reference in any law, regulation, document, record, map, or other paper of the United States to the building referred to in section 1 is deemed to be a reference to the "Edward Thaxter Gignoux United States Courthouse".
