CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To recognize and encourage the convening of a National
Silver Haired Congress.

Whereas many States have encouraged and facilitated the
creation of senior citizen legislative and advocacy bodies;

Whereas in creating such bodies these States have provided
many older Americans the opportunity to express con-
cerns, promote appropriate interests, and advance the
common good by influencing legislation and actions of
State government; and

Whereas a National Silver Haired Congress, with representa-
tives from each State, would provide a national forum for
a nonpartisan evaluation of grassroots solutions to con-
cerns shared by an increasing number of older Ameri-
cans: Now, therefore, be it
