Mr. KLECZKA introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

JOINT RESOLUTION

Designating the week of October 24 through 30, 1993, as
“National Health Care Quality Week”.

Whereas the quality of the health care system of the United States is a matter of deep concern to all Americans;

Whereas there is great governmental concern regarding the maintenance of high quality standards for this country’s health care system;

Whereas responsibility for the quality of this country’s health care system rests largely with health care quality professionals;

Whereas health care quality professionals are increasing their commitment to provide the highest possible quality of patient care;

Whereas the National Association for Healthcare Quality has established a special week to celebrate health care quality; and

Whereas we support all efforts by health care quality professionals to achieve the highest possible standards of health care quality: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the week of October 24 through 30, 1993, is des-
4 ignated as “National Health Care Quality Week”, and the
5 President is authorized and requested to issue a proclama-
6 tion calling upon the people of the United States to ob-
7 serve such day with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
