Mr. DOOLITTLE introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

JOINT RESOLUTION

Designating May 1994 as “National Community Residential Care Month”.

Whereas the need for quality, dependable health care for the elderly, disabled, and mentally ill increases each year;

Whereas community residential care fulfills medical, social, and nutritional assistance to those in need and who cannot care for themselves;

Whereas the community residential care industry is both national and international, and it is deserving of recognition and appreciation;

Whereas the community residential care industry is staffed by committed, hardworking professionals who dedicate

their working lives to the care of the elderly, the disabled,
and the mentally ill;

Whereas those providing community residential care must
meet stringent licensing requirements; and

Whereas the community residential care industry provides a
uniquely workable and homelike environment for those
unable to care for themselves at home in a manner which
promotes confidence, support, and self-esteem: Now,
therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That May 1994 is designated as “National Community
4 Residential Care Month”. The President is authorized and
5 requested to issue a proclamation calling on the people of
6 the United States to observe such month with appropriate
7 ceremonies and activities.
