Mr. OWENS of New York introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to provide that the United States shall guarantee to each person the right to employment opportunity.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*
3 *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-*
4 *lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-*
5 *stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all*
6 *intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when*
7 *ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several*

1 States within seven years after the date of its submission
2 by the Congress:

3 “ARTICLE —

4 “SECTION 1. The right to employment opportunity
5 shall be guaranteed to each person by the United States.

6 “SECTION 2. The Congress shall have power to en-
7 force this article by appropriate legislation.

8 “SECTION 3. This article shall take effect on the date
9 of its ratification.”.
