Mr. TRAFICANT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to authorize the Secretary of Defense to assign Department of Defense personnel to assist the Immigration and Naturalization Service and the United States Customs Service perform their border protection functions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DETAIL OF DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE PER-**
2 **SONNEL TO ASSIST IMMIGRATION AND NATU-**
3 **RALIZATION SERVICE AND CUSTOMS SERV-**
4 **ICE.**

5 (a) **AUTHORITY OF SECRETARY OF DEFENSE.**—Sec-
6 tion 374 of title 10, United States Code, is amended by
7 adding at the end the following new subsection:

8 “(d)(1) During each fiscal year, the Secretary of De-
9 fense may make not more than 10,000 Department of De-
10 fense personnel available to assist—

11 “(A) at the request of the Attorney General,
12 the Immigration and Naturalization Service in pre-
13 venting the entry of terrorists, drug traffickers, and
14 illegal aliens into the United States; and

15 “(B) at the request of the Secretary of the
16 Treasury, the United States Customs Service in the
17 inspection of cargo, vehicles, and aircraft at points
18 of entry into the United States.

19 “(2) Section 377 of this title shall apply in the case
20 of Department of Defense personnel made available under
21 paragraph (1).”.

22 (b) **CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.**—The heading of such
23 section is amended to read as follows:

1 **“§374. Use of personnel to maintain and operate**
2 **equipment and to provide other assist-**
3 **ance**

4 (2) The item relating to such section in the table of
5 sections at the beginning of chapter 18 of title 10, United
6 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

“374. Use of personnel to maintain and operate equipment and to provide other
assistance.”.

7 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (d) of section 374
8 of title 10, United States Code, as added by subsection
9 (a), shall take effect on October 1, 1993.
