A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to prohibit transportation of illegal aliens for purposes of employment.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Illegal Alien Transpor-
5 tation Prevention Act of 1993”.

1 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF TRANSPORTATION OF ALIENS FOR**2 PURPOSES OF EMPLOYMENT.**

3 Section 274(a)(1)(B) of the Immigration and Nation-
4 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1324(a)(1)(B)) is amended by insert-
5 ing before the semicolon at the end the following: “or in
6 furtherance of the employment of such alien”.
