A BILL

To prohibit Federal financial assistance to localities whose officials refuse to cooperate in the arrest and deportation of an alien unlawfully present in the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSIST-**
2 **ANCE TO LOCALITIES THAT REFUSE TO CO-**
3 **OPERATE IN THE ARREST AND DEPORTATION**
4 **OF UNLAWFUL ALIENS.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Fed-
6 eral financial assistance shall be paid to any local govern-
7 ment on and after such date as the Attorney General cer-
8 tifies that an official, officer, or employee of the local gov-
9 ernment (including its police department) in the exercise
10 of (and within the lawful scope of) the individual's official
11 duties has refused, on or after the date of the enactment
12 of this Act, to cooperate with an officer or employee of
13 the Department of Justice (including the Immigration and
14 Naturalization Service) with respect to the arrest and de-
15 portation of an alien who is not lawfully present within
16 the United States.
