- 3 SECTION 1. AWARDS OF PELL GRANTS TO PRISONERS PRO-
- 4 HIBITED.
- 5 Section 401(b)(8) the Higher Education Act of 1965
- 6 (20 U.S.C. 1070a(b)(8)) is amended to read as follows:
- 7 "(8) No basic grant shall be awarded under this sub-
- 8 part to any individual who is incarcerated in any Federal
- 9 or State penal institution.".

### 1 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 2 The amendment made by this Act shall apply with
- 3 respect to periods of enrollment beginning on or after the

4 date of enactment of this Act.
