16	liable under section 107 of such Act (42 U.S.C.

26	under any State law similar in subject matter

- 7 1141(d)(2) of title 11, United States Code, is amended—

- 10 "(B) The confirmation of the plan does not discharge
- 11 any debtor from a debt of a kind excepted from discharge
- 12 under section 523(a)(13) of this title.".
- 13 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.
- 14 (a) Effective Date.—Except as provided in sub-
- 15 section (b), the amendments made by section 1 shall take
- 16 effect on the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 17 (b) APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.—The amend-
- 18 ments made by section 1 shall not apply with respect to
- 19 cases commenced under title 11 of the United States Code
- 20 before the date of the enactment of this Act.
