Ms. PELOSI introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Transportation to convey for scrapping by the National Maritime Museum Association not more than 2 vessels in the National Defense Reserve Fleet that are scheduled to be scrapped.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF NDRF VESSELS FOR SCRAP-**
4 **PING BY NATIONAL MARITIME MUSEUM AS-**
5 **SOCIATION.**

6 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This section may be cited as the
7 “Historic Fleet Restoration Act of 1993”.

8 (b) VESSEL CONVEYANCE AUTHORITY.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other
2 law and subject to paragraph (2), the Secretary of
3 Transportation shall convey to the National Mari-
4 time Museum Association (a nonprofit organization
5 located in San Francisco, California; hereinafter in
6 this section referred to as the “Association”), with-
7 out consideration, all right, title, and interest of the
8 United States Government in not more than 2 ves-
9 sels which—

10 (A) are in the National Defense Reserve
11 Fleet on the date of the enactment of this sec-
12 tion;

13 (B) are each of not less than 4,000 dis-
14 placement tons;

15 (C) have no usefulness to the Government;
16 and

17 (D) are scheduled to be scrapped.

18 (2) CONDITION.—As a condition of conveying
19 any vessel to the Association pursuant to this sec-
20 tion, the Secretary shall require that the Association
21 enter into an agreement with the Secretary which re-
22 quires that the Association—

23 (A) sell the vessel for scrap purposes;

24 (B) use the proceeds of that scrapping for
25 expenses directly related to the preservation

1 and restoration of the historic fleet of the San
2 Francisco Maritime National Historical Park,
3 located in San Francisco, California;

4 (C) have raised, before the date of the con-
5 veyance, at least \$100,000 from non-Federal
6 sources for use for the support of the San
7 Francisco Maritime National Historical Park;
8 and

9 (D) comply with any other conditions the
10 Secretary considers appropriate.

11 (c) DELIVERY.—The Secretary shall deliver any ves-
12 sel conveyed under this section to the Association—

13 (1) at the place where the vessel is located on
14 the date of the approval of the conveyance;

15 (2) in its condition on that date; and

16 (3) without cost to the Government.

17 (d) EXPIRATION.—The authority of the Secretary to
18 convey vessels under this section expires on the date which
19 is 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

20 (e) TREATMENT OF AMOUNTS AVAILABLE TO ASSO-
21 CIATION.—Amounts available to, or used by, the Associa-
22 tion pursuant to subparagraph (B) or (C) of subsection
23 (b)(2) shall not be considered in any determination of the
24 amounts available to the Department of the Interior for
25 the San Francisco Maritime National Historical Park.

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
