## A BILL

For the relief of Chi Hsii Tsui, Jin Mie Tsui, Yin Whee Tsui, Yin Tao Tsui, and Yin Chao Tsui.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR CHI HSII**  
4 **TSUI, JIN MIE TSUI, YIN WHEE TSUI, YIN TAO**  
5 **TSUI, AND YIN CHAO TSUI.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 201(a)  
7 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Chi Hsii Tsui,  
8 Jin Mie Tsui, Yin Whee Tsui, Yin Tao Tsui, and Yin Chao  
9 Tsui shall be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa  
10 or for adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully

1 admitted for permanent residence upon filing an applica-  
2 tion for issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204  
3 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful perma-  
4 nent resident.

5 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Chi Hsii Tsui, Jin  
6 Mie Tsui, Yin Whee Tsui, Yin Tao Tsui, or Yin Chao Tsui  
7 enters the United States before the filing deadline speci-  
8 fied in subsection (c), he or she shall be considered to have  
9 entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligi-  
10 ble, be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245  
11 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of  
12 the enactment of this Act.

13 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
14 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-  
15 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-  
16 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees  
17 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

18 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—  
19 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-  
20 idence to Chi Hsii Tsui, Jin Mie Tsui, Yin Whee Tsui,  
21 Yin Tao Tsui, and Yin Chao Tsui, the Secretary of State  
22 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 5, during the  
23 current or next following fiscal year, the total number of  
24 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the  
25 country of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the

1 Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the  
2 total number of immigrant visas that are made available  
3 to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under section  
4 202(e) of such Act.
