A BILL

To provide that requirements relating to transport of certain agricultural commodities and other items shall not apply to certain assistance provided to Russia.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENTS NOT APPLICABLE TO TRANS-**
4 **PORT OF CERTAIN AGRICULTURAL COMMOD-**
5 **ITIES AND OTHER ITEMS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Sections 901(b) and 901b of the
7 Merchant Marine Act, 1936 (46 App. U.S.C. 1241(b),
8 1241f) shall not apply to carriage or transport of any agri-
9 cultural commodities or equipment, materials, products,

1 goods, or services to or for Russia under the Vancouver
2 Package.

3 (b) VANCOUVER PACKAGE DEFINED.—In this section
4 the term “Vancouver Package” means the United States
5 assistance for Russia that President Clinton outlined in
6 his meetings with the President of the Russian Federation
7 in Vancouver, Canada, in April 1993.
