3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR**

4 **THE AMERICAN FOLKLIFE CENTER.**

5 Section 8 of the American Folklife Preservation Act
6 (20 U.S.C. 2107) is amended—

7 (1) by striking out “and” after “September 30,
8 1992,”; and

9 (2) by inserting after “September 30, 1993”
10 the following: “, \$1,120,000 for the fiscal year end-

1 ing September 30, 1994, \$1,197,936 for the fiscal
2 year ending September 30, 1995, \$1,267,272 for the
3 fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, and
4 \$1,341,158 for the fiscal year ending September 30,
5 1997”.
