1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INSTANT PRINT CAMERAS.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting
6 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.90.07	Fixed focus instant print cameras (provided for in sub-heading 9006.40.40)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/96	”.
	9902.90.08	Instant print cameras, other than fixed focus, valued over \$10 each (provided for in sub-heading 9006.40.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/96
