A BILL

For the relief of John W. Ruth, Sr.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF CLAIM AGAINST THE UNITED
- 4 STATES.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
- 6 shall pay, out of money in the Treasury not otherwise ap-
- 7 propriated, to John W. Ruth, Sr., of Knoxville, Tennessee,
- 8 a sum of money as compensation for the losses he incurred
- 9 from 1969 through 1974 when he detrimentally relied on
- 10 assurances by Federal officials during his participation in
- 11 Federal efforts to build highways in the Appalachian re-
- 12 gion.

- 1 (b) Satisfaction of Claim.—The payment made
- 2 under subsection (a) shall be in full satisfaction of all
- 3 claims John W. Ruth, Sr., may have against the United
- 4 States in connection with the losses described in sub-
- 5 section (a).

6 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.

- 7 It shall be unlawful for an amount that exceeds 10
- 8 percent of the sum paid by the Secretary of the Treasury
- 9 under section 1 to be paid to or received by any agent
- 10 or attorney for services rendered in connection with the
- 11 benefits provided by this Act. Any person who violates this
- 12 section shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject
- 13 to a fine in the amount provided under title 18, United
- 14 States Code.
