A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to revise and extend programs relating to the prevention and control of injuries.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Injury Prevention and
- 5 Control Amendments of 1993".

1	ر SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF REQUIREMENTS WITH RE-
2	SPECT TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL
3	ASSAULT.
4	Part K of title III of the Public Health Service Act
5	(42 U.S.C. 280b et seq.) is amended—
6	(1) by redesignating sections 393 and 394 as
7	sections 394 and 394A, respectively; and
8	(2) by inserting after section 392 the following
9	section:
10	"DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT
11	"SEC. 393. With respect to activities that are author-
12	ized in sections 391 and 392, the Secretary, acting
13	through the Director of the Centers for Disease Control
14	and Prevention, shall carry out such activities with respect
15	to domestic violence and sexual assault. Activities author-
16	ized in the preceding sentence include—
17	"(1) collecting data relating to the incidence of
18	such violence and assault;
19	"(2) making grants to public and nonprofit pri-
20	vate entities for the evaluation of programs whose
21	purpose is to prevent such violence and assault;
22	"(3) providing to the public information and
23	education on such violence and assault;
24	"(4) training health care providers to identify
25	individuals whose medical condition or statements
26	indicate that the individuals are victims of such vio-
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lence or assault, and to refer the individuals to enti ties that provide services regarding such violence
 and assault; and

4 "(5) making grants to public and nonprofit pri5 vate entities for demonstration projects with respect
6 to such violence and assault.".

7 SEC. 3. ADVISORY COMMITTEE; REPORTS.

8 Section 394 of the Public Health Service Act, as rede-9 signed by section 2(1) of this Act, is amended to read as 10 follows:

11 "GENERAL PROVISIONS

"SEC. 394. (a) The Secretary, acting through the Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
shall establish an advisory committee to advise the Secretary and such Director with respect to the prevention
and control of injuries.

17 "(b) Not later than February 1 of 1994 and of every second year thereafter, the Secretary, acting through the 18 Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Preven-19 tion, shall submit to the Committee on Energy and Com-20 merce of the House of Representatives, and to the Com-21 22mittee on Labor and Human Resources of the Senate, a report describing the activities carried out under this part 23 during the preceding 2 fiscal years. Such report shall in-24 clude a description of such activities that were carried out 25

with respect to domestic violence and sexual assault and
 with respect to rural areas.".

3 SEC. 4. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

4 (a) TERMINOLOGY.—Part K of title III of the Public
5 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280b et seq.) is amended—

6 (1) in the heading for such part, by striking
7 "INJURY CONTROL" and inserting "PREVENTION
8 AND CONTROL OF INJURIES"; and

9 (2) in section 392—

10 (A) in the heading for such section, by in11 serting "PREVENTION AND" before "CONTROL
12 ACTIVITIES";

(B) in subsection (a)(1), by inserting "and
control" after "prevention"; and

15 (C) in subsection (b)(1), by striking "inju16 ries and injury control" and inserting "the pre17 vention and control of injuries".

(b) PROVISIONS RELATING TO PUBLIC LAW 102–
531.—Part K of title III of the Public Health Service Act
(42 U.S.C. 280b et seq.), as amended by section 301 of
Public Law 102–531 (106 Stat. 3482), is amended—

(1) in section 392(b)(2), by striking "to promote injury control" and all that follows and inserting "to promote activities regarding the prevention
and control of injuries; and"; and

1 (2) in section 391(b), by adding at the end the 2 following sentence: "In carrying out the preceding 3 sentence, the Secretary shall disseminate such infor-4 mation to the public, including through elementary 5 and secondary schools.".

6 SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

Section 394A of the Public Health Service Act, as
redesignated by section 2(1) of this Act, is amended by
striking "To carry out" and all that follows and inserting
the following: "For the purpose of carrying out this part,
there are authorized to be appropriated \$50,000,000 for
fiscal year 1994, and such sums as may be necessary for
each of the fiscal years 1995 through 1998.".

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
