

1 (1) by redesignating sections 393 and 394 as
2 sections 394 and 394A, respectively; and

3 (2) by inserting after section 392 the following
4 section:

5 “DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT

6 “SEC. 393. With respect to activities that are author-
7 ized in sections 391 and 392, the Secretary, acting
8 through the Director of the Centers for Disease Control
9 and Prevention, shall carry out such activities with respect
10 to domestic violence and sexual assault. Activities author-
11 ized in the preceding sentence include—

12 “(1) collecting data relating to the incidence of
13 such violence and assault;

14 “(2) making grants to public and nonprofit pri-
15 vate entities for the evaluation of programs whose
16 purpose is to prevent such violence and assault;

17 “(3) providing to the public information and
18 education on such violence and assault;

19 “(4) training health care providers to identify
20 individuals whose medical condition or statements
21 indicate that the individuals are victims of such vio-
22 lence or assault, and to refer the individuals to enti-
23 ties that provide services regarding such violence
24 and assault; and

1 “(5) making grants to public and nonprofit pri-
2 vate entities for demonstration projects with respect
3 to such violence and assault.”.

4 **SEC. 3. ADVISORY COMMITTEE; REPORTS.**

5 Section 394 of the Public Health Service Act, as rede-
6 signed by section 2(1) of this Act, is amended to read as
7 follows:

8 “GENERAL PROVISIONS

9 “SEC. 394. (a) The Secretary, acting through the Di-
10 rector of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
11 shall establish an advisory committee to advise the Sec-
12 retary and such Director with respect to the prevention
13 and control of injuries.

14 “(b) Not later than February 1 of 1994 and of every
15 second year thereafter, the Secretary, acting through the
16 Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Preven-
17 tion, shall submit to the Committee on Energy and Com-
18 merce of the House of Representatives, and to the Com-
19 mittee on Labor and Human Resources of the Senate, a
20 report describing the activities carried out under this part
21 during the preceding 2 fiscal years. Such report shall in-
22 clude a description of such activities that were carried out
23 with respect to domestic violence and sexual assault and
24 with respect to rural areas.”.

1 **SEC. 4. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.**

2 (a) TERMINOLOGY.—Part K of title III of the Public
3 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280b et seq.) is amended—

4 (1) in the heading for such part, by striking
5 “INJURY CONTROL” and inserting “PREVENTION
6 AND CONTROL OF INJURIES”; and

7 (2) in section 392—

8 (A) in the heading for such section, by in-
9 serting “PREVENTION AND” before “CONTROL
10 ACTIVITIES”;

11 (B) in subsection (a)(1), by inserting “and
12 control” after “prevention”; and

13 (C) in subsection (b)(1), by striking “inju-
14 ries and injury control” and inserting “the pre-
15 vention and control of injuries”.

16 (b) PROVISIONS RELATING TO PUBLIC LAW 102-
17 531.—Part K of title III of the Public Health Service Act
18 (42 U.S.C. 280b et seq.), as amended by section 301 of
19 Public Law 102-531 (106 Stat. 3482), is amended—

20 (1) in section 392(b)(2), by striking “to pro-
21 mote injury control” and all that follows and insert-
22 ing “to promote activities regarding the prevention
23 and control of injuries; and”; and

24 (2) in section 391(b), by adding at the end the
25 following sentence: “In carrying out the preceding
26 sentence, the Secretary shall disseminate such infor-

1 mation to the public, including through elementary
2 and secondary schools.”.

3 **SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4 Section 394A of the Public Health Service Act, as
5 redesignated by section 2(1) of this Act, is amended by
6 striking “To carry out” and all that follows and inserting
7 the following: “For the purpose of carrying out this part,
8 there are authorized to be appropriated \$50,000,000 for
9 fiscal year 1994, and such sums as may be necessary for
10 each of the fiscal years 1995 through 1998.”.
