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A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to revise and extend programs relating to the prevention and control of injuries.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Injury Prevention and3 Control Amendments of 1993".

4 SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF REQUIREMENTS WITH RE5 SPECT TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL
6 ASSAULT.

Part K of title III of the Public Health Service Act
(42 U.S.C. 280b et seq.) is amended—

9 (1) by redesignating sections 393 and 394 as 10 sections 394 and 394A, respectively; and

11 (2) by inserting after section 392 the following12 section:

13 "DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT

14 "SEC. 393. With respect to activities that are author-15 ized in sections 391 and 392, the Secretary, acting 16 through the Director of the Centers for Disease Control 17 and Prevention, shall carry out such activities with respect 18 to domestic violence and sexual assault. Activities author-19 ized in the preceding sentence include—

20 "(1) collecting data relating to the incidence of21 such violence and assault;

"(2) making grants to public and nonprofit private entities for the evaluation of programs whose
purpose is to prevent such violence and assault;

25 "(3) providing to the public information and26 education on such violence and assault;

1 "(4) training health care providers to identify 2 individuals whose medical condition or statements 3 indicate that the individuals are victims of such vio-4 lence or assault, and to refer the individuals to enti-5 ties that provide services regarding such violence 6 and assault; and

7 ''(5) making grants to public and nonprofit pri8 vate entities for demonstration projects with respect
9 to such violence and assault.''.

10 SEC. 3. ADVISORY COMMITTEE; REPORTS.

Section 394 of the Public Health Service Act, as redesigned by section 2(1) of this Act, is amended to read as
follows:

14 "GENERAL PROVISIONS

"SEC. 394. (a) The Secretary, acting through the Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
shall establish an advisory committee to advise the Secretary and such Director with respect to the prevention
and control of injuries.

"(b) Not later than February 1 of 1994 and of every
second year thereafter, the Secretary, acting through the
Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, shall submit to the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House of Representatives, and to the Committee on Labor and Human Resources of the Senate, a
report describing the activities carried out under this part
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during the preceding 2 fiscal years. Such report shall in clude a description of such activities that were carried out
 with respect to domestic violence and sexual assault and
 with respect to rural areas.".

5 SEC. 4. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

6 (a) TERMINOLOGY.—Part K of title III of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280b et seq.) is amended— 7 (1) in the heading for such part, by striking 8 "INJURY CONTROL" and inserting "PREVENTION 9 AND CONTROL OF INJURIES"; and 10 11 (2) in section 392— (A) in the heading for such section, by in-12 serting "PREVENTION AND" before "CONTROL 13 14 ACTIVITIES": 15 (B) in subsection (a)(1), by inserting "and control" after "prevention"; and 16 17 (C) in subsection (b)(1), by striking "inju-18 ries and injury control" and inserting "the pre-19 vention and control of injuries". 20 (b) PROVISIONS RELATING TO PUBLIC LAW 102-21 531.—Part K of title III of the Public Health Service Act 22 (42 U.S.C. 280b et seq.), as amended by section 301 of 23 Public Law 102–531 (106 Stat. 3482), is amended— (1) in section 392(b)(2), by striking "to pro-24 mote injury control" and all that follows and insert-25

ing "to promote activities regarding the prevention
 and control of injuries; and"; and

3 (2) in section 391(b), by adding at the end the
4 following sentence: "In carrying out the preceding
5 sentence, the Secretary shall disseminate such infor6 mation to the public, including through elementary
7 and secondary schools.".

8 SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

9 Section 394A of the Public Health Service Act, as 10 redesignated by section 2(1) of this Act, is amended by 11 striking "To carry out" and all that follows and inserting 12 the following: "For the purpose of carrying out this part, 13 there are authorized to be appropriated \$50,000,000 for 14 fiscal year 1994, and such sums as may be necessary for 15 each of the fiscal years 1995 through 1998.".
