## A BILL

To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to reduce the amount that a multicandidate political committee may contribute to a House of Representatives candidate.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDUCTION IN AMOUNT OF MULTICANDIDATE**  
4 **POLITICAL COMMITTEE CONTRIBUTIONS TO**  
5 **A HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CANDIDATE.**

6 Section 315(a)(2)(A) of the Federal Election Cam-  
7 paign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 441a(a)(2)(A)) is amended  
8 by inserting after “\$5,000” the following: “, except that,

1 in the case of a candidate for the office of Representative  
2 in, or Delegate or Resident Commissioner to, the Con-  
3 gress, the limitation shall be \$1,000”.
