- 3 SECTION 1. PROTECTION OF THE NORTH FORK PAYETTE
- 4 RIVER.
- 5 In order to protect for present and future generations
- 6 the outstanding scenic, natural, and recreational values of
- 7 the North Fork of the Payette River between Cabarton
- 8 Bridge and Banks in the State of Idaho, the protections
- 9 afforded by section 7(a) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers
- 10 Act (16 U.S.C. 1278(a)) for rivers designated under sec-

- 1 tion 3(a) of that Act shall apply to the 25-mile segment
- 2 of such river downstream of Cabarton Bridge and up-
- 3 stream of the confluence of the river with the South Fork

4 of the Payette at Banks.
