## A BILL

To apply certain provisions of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act to a segment of the North Fork of the Payette River in Idaho.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PROTECTION OF THE NORTH FORK PAYETTE**  
2 **RIVER.**

3 In order to protect for present and future generations  
4 the outstanding scenic, natural, and recreational values of  
5 the North Fork of the Payette River between Cabarton  
6 Bridge and Banks in the State of Idaho, the protections  
7 afforded by section 7(a) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers  
8 Act (16 U.S.C. 1278(a)) for rivers designated under sec-  
9 tion 3(a) of that Act shall apply to the 25-mile segment  
10 of such river downstream of Cabarton Bridge and up-  
11 stream of the confluence of the river with the South Fork  
12 of the Payette at Banks.

13 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

14 *The provisions of this Act shall remain in effect so long*  
15 *as there remain in effect the laws of the State of Idaho that*  
16 *as of the date of enactment of this Act prohibited develop-*  
17 *ment of hydroelectric projects (including dams, water con-*  
18 *duits, reservoirs, powerhouses and other project works) and*  
19 *other water resource projects on or directly affecting the seg-*  
20 *ment of the North Fork of the Payette River identified in*  
21 *section 1 of this Act.*
