1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENDING PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT IN**
4 **THE ADMISSION OF AMERASIAN CHILDREN**
5 **TO CHILDREN BORN IN THE PHILIPPINES.**

6 Section 204(f)(2)(A)(i) of the Immigration and Na-
7 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1154(f)(2)(A)(i)) is amended by

1 striking “the date of the enactment of this subsection”
2 and inserting “October 22, 1982, or was born in the Phil-
3ippines after 1950 and before August 24, 1993”.
