Ms. PELOSI (for herself, Mr. FAZIO, Mr. HAMBURG, and Mr. MILLER of California) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries

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## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a salmon captive broodstock program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Winter Run Chinook  
5 Salmon Captive Broodstock Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF SALMON CAPTIVE**  
7 **BROODSTOCK PROGRAM.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (d), the Sec-  
9 retary of the Interior (hereinafter in this section referred  
10 to as the “Secretary”) shall conduct in accordance with

1 this section a salmon captive broodstock program (herein-  
2 after in this section referred to as the “Program”).

3 (b) PROGRAM.—The Program shall consist of the de-  
4 velopment and implementation by the Secretary of the  
5 plan described in the document entitled “Modification of  
6 Permit #747: Application for Permit for Scientific Pur-  
7 poses Under The Endangered Species Act”, as submitted  
8 to the National Marine Fisheries Service on April 24,  
9 1992.

10 (c) CONSULTATION.—The Secretary shall consult  
11 with the Winter Run Chinook Salmon Captive Broodstock  
12 Committee (a nonprofit ad hoc committee convened by the  
13 Pacific Coast Federation of Fishermen’s Associations) in  
14 making management decisions regarding the Program.

15 (d) STATE MATCHING.—The Secretary may not im-  
16 plement this section unless not less than 20 percent of  
17 amounts necessary to conduct the Program are provided  
18 by non-Federal sources.

19 (e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
20 are authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to con-  
21 duct the Program \$10,900,000 for the 9-fiscal-year period  
22 beginning with fiscal year 1994.

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
