AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a salmon captive broodstock program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Winter Run Chinook
5 Salmon Captive Broodstock Act of 1993”.

1 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF SALMON CAPTIVE**
2 **BROODSTOCK PROGRAM.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Subject to subsection (d), the Sec-
4 retary of the Interior (hereinafter in this section referred
5 to as the “Secretary”) shall conduct in accordance with
6 this section a salmon captive broodstock program (herein-
7 after in this section referred to as the “Program”).

8 (b) **PROGRAM.**—The program shall be carried out in
9 a manner that is consistent with the goals, priorities, and
10 policies set forth in any recovery plan for winter run Chi-
11 nook salmon in the Sacramento River developed by the
12 National Marine Fisheries Service under the Endangered
13 Species Act of 1973, and with findings of consultations
14 regarding that population of salmon carried out pursuant
15 to section 7 of that Act.

16 (c) **CONSULTATION.**—The Secretary shall consult
17 with the Winter Run Chinook Salmon Captive Broodstock
18 Committee (a committee identified in the document enti-
19 tled “Biological Assessment on the Effects of Coleman
20 National Fish Hatchery Operations on Winter Run Chi-
21 nook Salmon”, prepared by the United States Fish and
22 Wildlife Service) in making management decisions regard-
23 ing the Program.

24 (d) **STATE MATCHING.**—The Secretary may not im-
25 plement this section unless not less than 20 percent of

1 amounts necessary to conduct the Program are provided
2 by non-Federal sources.

3 (e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
4 are authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to con-
5 duct the Program \$1,000,000 for each of fiscal years
6 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, and 1998.
