A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to provide for full benefits for disabled widows and widowers without regard to age.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. FULL BENEFITS FOR DISABLED WIDOWS AND

4 WIDOWERS WITHOUT REGARD TO AGE.

5 (a) ELIGIBILITY FOR WIDOW'S INSURANCE BENE6 FITS.—Section 202(e) of the Social Security Act (42
7 U.S.C. 402(e)) is amended—

(1) in paragraph (1)(B), by striking "has at-1 2 tained age 50 but has not attained age 60 and"; 3 (2) in paragraph (3)(A), by striking "after at-4 taining age 50 if she was entitled before such marriage occurred" and inserting "after having been en-5 titled''; and 6 (3) in paragraph (3)(B), by striking "after at-7 taining age 50". 8 9 (b) ELIGIBILITY OF WIDOWER'S INSURANCE BENE-FITS.—Section 202(f) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 402(f)) is 10 11 amended— (1) in paragraph (1)(B), by striking "has at-12 13 tained age 50 but has not attained age 60 and"; (2) in paragraph (3)(A), by striking "after at-14 15 taining age 50 if he was entitled before such marriage occurred" and inserting "after having been en-16 titled": and 17 18 (3) in paragraph (3)(B), by striking "after at-19 taining age 50". 20 SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FROM REDUCTIONS IN BENEFITS. 21 Section 202(q) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 22 402(q)) is amended— 23 (1) in paragraph (3)(A), by striking "age 50" and inserting "age 60"; and 24

(2) by adding at the end the following new
 paragraph:

3 "(12) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, there shall be no reduction under this subsection 4 in the widow's or widower's insurance benefit of an indi-5 vidual for any month in which such individual is under 6 7 a disability (as defined in section 223(d)); and none of the provisions of this subsection shall apply with respect 8 to such benefit even though such benefit may have been 9 so reduced prior to the onset of such disability.". 10

11 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE AND REDETERMINATION OF BEN12 EFITS.

The amendments made by this Act shall apply with 13 respect to monthly insurance benefits payable under title 14 15 II of the Social Security Act for months after the month in which this Act is enacted. The Secretary of Health and 16 Human Services (without the necessity of any application 17 therefor) shall redetermine the amount of any widow's or 18 widower's insurance benefit which is payable for the 19 month in which this Act is enacted in order to reflect such 20 amendments as provided in the preceding sentence. 21
