A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That this Act may be cited as the “Miscellaneous Small
4 Business Amendments Act of 1993”.

5 CERTIFIED DEVELOPMENT COMPANY AUTHORIZATIONS

6 SEC. 2. Section 20 of the Small Business Act (15
7 U.S.C. 631 note) is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (g)(2) by striking
9 “\$7,030,000,000” and by inserting in lieu thereof
10 “\$7,155,000,000”;

1 (2) in subsection (g)(2) by striking
2 “\$775,000,000” and by inserting in lieu thereof
3 “\$900,000,000”;

4 (3) in subsection (i)(2) by striking
5 “\$8,083,000,000” and by inserting in lieu thereof
6 “\$8,458,000,000”; and

7 (4) in subsection (i)(2) by striking
8 “\$825,000,000” and by inserting in lieu thereof
9 “\$1,200,000,000”.

10 WHITE HOUSE SMALL BUSINESS CONFERENCE

11 SEC. 3. The White House Conference on Small Busi-
12 ness Authorization Act (15 U.S.C. 631 note) is amend-
13 ed—

14 (1) in section 2 by striking from subsection (a)
15 “not earlier than January 1, 1994, and not later
16 than April 1, 1994” and by inserting in lieu thereof
17 “not earlier than October 1, 1995, and not later
18 than December 31, 1995”;

19 (2) in section 2 by striking from subsection (a)
20 “December 1, 1992” and by inserting in lieu thereof
21 “November 15, 1994”;

22 (3) in section 5 by striking the second sentence
23 of subsection (a) and by inserting in lieu thereof the
24 following: “Subsequent to the date of enactment of
25 the Miscellaneous Small Business Amendments Act
26 of 1993, but not later than thirty days after the date

1 of enactment of such Act, the President shall select
2 and appoint eleven individuals to the Commission.”;
3 and

4 (4) in section 9 by striking from subsection (a)
5 “\$5,000,000” and by inserting in lieu thereof
6 “\$7,000,000”.

7 SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTER PROGRAMS

8 SEC. 4. (a) Section 21(c)(7) of the Small Business
9 Act (15 U.S.C. 648) is amended by striking “system which
10 will” and by inserting in lieu thereof the following: “sys-
11 tem. Subject to amounts approved in advance in appro-
12 priations Acts, the Administration may make grants or
13 enter cooperative agreements with one or more centers to
14 carry out the provisions of this paragraph. The matching
15 funds provisions of subsection (a) shall not be applicable
16 to grants or cooperative agreements under this paragraph.
17 The system shall”.

18 (b) Section 25(i) of the Small Business Act (15
19 U.S.C. 652) is amended by striking “\$8,000,000 for fiscal
20 year 1993” and by inserting in lieu thereof “\$2,000,000
21 for each of fiscal years 1993, 1994, 1995, and 1996”.

22 (c) Section 223 of the Small Business Credit and
23 Business Opportunity Enhancement Act of 1992 (106
24 Stat. 986) is amended by striking the last sentence of sub-
25 section (b).
