A BILL

For the relief of Richard Wayne Tribble and Tammy Tribble.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION FOR CLAIMS AGAINST UNITED**
4 **STATES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Richard Wayne Tribble and
6 Tammy Tribble may bring claims against the United
7 States under chapter 171 of title 28, United States Code,
8 for damages arising out of a surgical procedure performed
9 on the left knee of Richard Wayne Tribble at the United
10 States Naval Hospital on Guam on October 3, 1989, not-
11 withstanding—

1 (1) any law or legal doctrine that provides that
2 the United States is not liable for an injury to a
3 member of the armed forces of the United States
4 that arises out of or is in the course of activity inci-
5 dent to military service; and

6 (2) the time limitations established in section
7 2401(b) of title 28, United States Code.

8 (b) DEADLINE.—Subsection (a) shall apply only to
9 claims presented in writing to the appropriate Federal
10 agency pursuant to section 2675 of title 28, United States
11 Code, before the expiration of the 1-year period beginning
12 on the date of the enactment of this Act.
