A BILL

To deem the Florida Panther to be an endangered species
under the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FLORIDA PANTHER DECLARED ENDANGERED**
4 **SPECIES.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the spe-
6 cies commonly known as the “Florida Panther” is deemed
7 to be an endangered species for purposes of the Endan-
8 gered Species Act of 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1531).

1 **SEC. 2. LISTING OF FLORIDA PANTHER.**

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
3 retary of the Interior shall include the species known as
4 the “Florida Panther” in the list published under section
5 4(d) of the Endangered Species Act of 1973 (16 U.S.C.
6 1533(d)).
