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## A BILL

1 **SECTION. 1. TEMPORARY EXTENSION OF METHOD FOR DE-**  
2 **TERMINING GOVERNMENT CONTRIBUTIONS**  
3 **UNDER FEHBP IN THE ABSENCE OF A GOV-**  
4 **ERNMENT-WIDE INDEMNITY BENEFIT PLAN.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Public Law 101–76 (5 U.S.C.  
6 8906 note) is amended in subsection (a)(1) by striking  
7 “1993” and inserting “1996”.

8 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the  
9 Congress that nothing in this section should be considered  
10 to reflect any view on the appropriateness, merits, or tim-  
11 ing, or any other aspect of any comprehensive health care  
12 reform legislation.

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
