

AMENDMENT

In the Senate of the United States,

October 3 (legislative day, September 12), 1994.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 2826) entitled "An Act to provide for an investigation of the whereabouts of the United States citizens and others who have been missing from Cyprus since 1974", do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert: 1 *SECTION 1. UNITED STATES CITIZENS MISSING FROM CY*-2 *PRUS.*

(a) INVESTIGATION.—As soon as is practicable, the 3 President shall undertake, in cooperation with appropriate 4 5 international organizations or nongovernmental organizations, a thorough investigation of the whereabouts of the 6 United States citizens who have been missing from Cyprus 7 since 1974. Any information on others missing from Cyprus 8 that is learned or discovered during this investigation shall 9 be reported to the appropriate international or nongovern-10 mental organizations. The investigation shall focus on the 11 countries and communities which were combatants in Cy-12 prus in 1974, all of which currently receive United States 13 14 foreign assistance.

(b) REPORT TO THE FAMILIES.—The President shall
 report the findings of this investigation of the missing
 Americans to the family of each of the United States citi zens. Such reports shall include the whereabouts of the miss ing.

6 (c) REPORT TO THE CONGRESS.—The information
7 learned or discovered during this investigation shall be re8 ported to the Congress.

9 (d) RETURNING THE MISSING.—The President, in co10 operation with appropriate international organizations or
11 nongovernmental organizations, shall do everything possible
12 to return to their families, as soon as is practicable, the
13 United States citizens who have been missing from Cyprus
14 since 1974, and others who have been missing, including
15 returning the remains of those who are no longer alive. Attest:
