## A BILL

To fix rates of pay for Members of Congress at the levels which were in effect immediately before the enactment of the Ethics Reform Act of 1989.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RATES OF PAY.**

4 Section 601(a) of the Legislative Reorganization Act  
5 of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 31) is amended to read as follows:

6 “(a) The annual rate of pay for—

7 “(1) each Senator, Member of the House of  
8 Representatives, and Delegate to the House of Rep-

1        representatives, and the Resident Commissioner from  
2        Puerto Rico,

3            “(2) the President pro tempore of the Senate,  
4        the majority leader and the minority leader of the  
5        Senate, and the majority leader and the minority  
6        leader of the House of Representatives, and

7            “(3) the Speaker of the House of Representa-  
8        tives,

9 shall be the rate payable for each of those positions, re-  
10 spectively, as of November 29, 1989.”.

11 **SEC. 2. COORDINATION WITH OTHER PROVISIONS OF LAW.**

12        The second sentence of section 603 of the Ethics Re-  
13 form Act of 1989 (2 U.S.C. 31–1 note) and the second  
14 sentence of section 804(f) of such Act (Public Law 101–  
15 194; 103 Stat. 1778) are repealed.

16 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

17        (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendments made by this  
18 Act shall become effective as of the beginning of the first  
19 Congress commencing after the first election of Represent-  
20 atives which occurs after the date of the enactment of this  
21 Act.

22        (b) DEFINITIONS.—For the purpose of this section,  
23 the term “election of Representatives” shall have the  
24 meaning given such term by section 225(i)(4)(B) of the  
25 Federal Salary Act of 1967 (2 U.S.C. 359(4)(B)).
