- 7 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1448(d)) is amended
- 8 by adding at the end "All public ceremonies in which the

- 1 oath of allegiance is administered pursuant to this section
- 2 shall be conducted solely in the English language.".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 subsection (a) shall take effect 60 days after the date of

5 enactment of this Act.
