## A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act to reduce funding if States do not enact legislation that requires the death penalty in certain cases.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANT REDUCTION FOR NONCOMPLIANCE.**

4 Section 506 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control  
5 and Safe Streets Act of 1968 is amended by adding at  
6 the end the following:

7 “(g)(1) In order not to reduce the funds available  
8 under this subpart by 25 percent (for redistribution to

1 other participating States), a State shall, on the first day  
2 of each fiscal year succeeding the first fiscal year begin-  
3 ning after September 30, 1994, have in effect throughout  
4 the State in such fiscal year a law which requires a sen-  
5 tence of death to be imposed when a law enforcement offi-  
6 cer is killed in the line of duty.

7 “(2) For purposes of this subsection, the term ‘law  
8 enforcement officer’ has the same meaning given such  
9 term in section 1204(5).”.
