Mr. PICKETT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to revise a map relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL REVISIONS TO MAP.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior
5 shall, before the end of the 30-day period beginning on
6 the date of the enactment of this Act, make such technical
7 revisions to the map described in subsection (b) as are
8 necessary to ensure that depictions on that map of areas
9 as “otherwise protected areas”—

1 (1) do not include any area that is not an oth-
2 erwise protected area within the meaning of that
3 term under section 12 of the Coastal Barrier Im-
4 provement Act of 1990 (16 U.S.C. 3503 note); and

5 (2) do not include any of the area described as
6 follows:

7 Beginning at a point located at the intersection
8 of the westerly right-of-way line of the present Sand-
9 piper Road (60.00 feet wide) at the northern prop-
10 erty line of the property now owned by the City of
11 Virginia Beach, acquired by deed from Washington's
12 Forest, Inc., dated December 26, 1965, and duly re-
13 corded in the Circuit Court of the City of Virginia
14 Beach, Virginia, in Deed Book 932 page 32, and
15 running; thence—

16 (A) south 82 degrees, 50 minutes, 00 sec-
17 onds west, a distance of 1615.19 feet to a
18 point; thence,

19 (B) north 08 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 sec-
20 onds west, a distance of 531.84 feet to a point;
21 thence,

22 (C) north 78 degrees, 33 minutes, 00 sec-
23 onds east, a distance of 2268.56 feet to a point;
24 thence,

1 (D) south 11 degrees, 27 minutes, 00 sec-
2 onds east, a distance 302.06 feet to a point;
3 thence,

4 (E) south 82 degrees, 50 minutes, 00 sec-
5 onds west, a distance of 110.15 feet to a point;
6 thence,

7 (F) south 15 degrees, 06 minutes, 52 sec-
8 onds east, a distance of 403.88 feet to a point;
9 thence, and

10 (G) south 82 degrees, 50 minutes, 00 sec-
11 onds west, a distance of 607.55 feet to the
12 point or place of beginning;

13 containing approximately 31.4 acres.

14 (b) MAP DESCRIBED.—The map referred to in sub-
15 section (a) is—

16 (1) included in a set of maps entitled “Coastal
17 Barrier Resources System”, dated October 24, 1990;
18 and

19 (2) entitled “Back Bay Unit, VA-62P”.

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
