AN ACT

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to restore certain benefits eligibility to unremarried surviving spouses of veterans.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Surviving Spouses"5 Benefits Act of 1993".

6 SEC. 2. SPECIAL DEATH GRATUITY FOR UNREMARRIED
7 SURVIVING SPOUSES.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 13 of title 38, United 9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end of sub-10 chapter II the following new section: 1 "§1319. Special death gratuity

"In any case in which benefits under this chapter 2 have been terminated or denied as the result of a marriage 3 by a surviving spouse and in which such marriage has sub-4 sequently been terminated by death or divorce, a special 5 monthly death gratuity shall be payable to an unremarried 6 7 surviving spouse in an amount equal to the amount payable under section 1311(a)(1) of this title, subject to a 8 reduction of \$1 for each \$1 of income countable under 9 10 section 1315(f)(1) of this title.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting
after the item relating to section 1318 the following new
item:

"1319. Special death gratuity.".

15 SEC. 3. RESTORATION OF PENSION ELIGIBILITY FOR16UNREMARRIED SPOUSES.

17 Section 1501 of title 38, United States Code, is 18 amended by adding at the end the following new para-19 graph:

20 "(5) The term 'surviving spouse' includes the spouse 21 of a deceased veteran whose eligibility for benefits under 22 this chapter as a surviving spouse was terminated or de-23 nied by reason of a subsequent remarriage if such subse-24 quent remarriage is terminated by death or divorce.". 3 Section 2402(5) of title 38, United States Code, is 4 amended by inserting "(which for purposes of this chapter 5 includes an unremarried surviving spouse who had a sub-6 sequent remarriage which was terminated by death or di-7 vorce)" after "surviving spouse".

8 SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (b), the 10 amendments made by sections 2 and 3 shall take effect 11 on December 1, 1994.

12 (b) CONTINGENCY.—The amendments made by sec-13 tions 2 and 3 shall not take effect if there has not been 14 enacted as of December 1, 1994, a law providing a cost-15 of-living adjustment in the rates of compensation payable 16 under chapter 11 or dependency and indemnity compensa-17 tion payable under chapter 13 of title 38, United States 18 Code, for fiscal year 1995.

19 SEC. 6. POLICY REGARDING COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT

(a) ROUNDING DOWN.—The fiscal year 1995 cost-ofliving adjustments in the rates of and limitations for compensation payable under chapter 11 of title 38, United
States Code, and of dependency and indemnity compensation payable under chapter 13 of such title will be no more
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than a percentage equal to the percentage by which benefit 1 amounts payable under title II of the Social Security Act 2 (42 U.S.C. 401 et seq.) are increased effective December 3 4 1, 1994, as a result of a determination under section 215(i) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 415(i)), with all increased 5 monthly rates and limitations (other than increased rates 6 7 or limitations equal to a whole dollar amount) rounded down to the next lower dollar. 8

9 (b) LIMITATION ON FISCAL YEAR 1995 COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT FOR CERTAIN DIC RECIPIENTS.— 10 (1) During fiscal year 1995, the amount of any increase 11 in any of the rates of dependency and indemnity com-12 pensation in effect under section 1311(a)(3) of title 38, 13 United States Code, will not exceed 50 percent of the new 14 law increase, rounded down (if not an even dollar amount) 15 to the next lower dollar. 16

17 (2) For purposes of paragraph (1), the new law in18 crease is the amount by which the rate of dependency and
19 indemnity compensation provided for recipients under sec20 tion 1311(a)(1) of such title is increased for fiscal year
21 1995.
