

AMENDMENTS

In the Senate of the United States,

September 30 (legislative day, September 12), 1994.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 3485) entitled "An Act to authorize appropriations for carrying out the Earthquake Hazards Reduction Act of 1977 for fiscal years 1994, 1995, and 1996", do pass with the following

AMENDMENTS:

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert:

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1 SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
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- Section 12 of the Earthquake Hazards Reduction Act

- 4 (1) in subsection (a)(7)—
- 5 (A) by inserting "of the Agency" after "to

- 7 (B) by striking "and" after "September 30,
 8 1992,"; and
- 9 (C) by inserting '', \$25,000,000 for the fis-10 cal year ending September 30, 1995, and

2	30, 1996'' after ''September 30, 1993'';
3	(2) in subsection (b)—
4	(A) by striking ''and'' after ''September 30,
5	1992;''; and
6	(B) by inserting ''; \$49,200,000 for the fis-
7	cal year ending September 30, 1995; and
8	\$50,676,000 for the fiscal year ending September
9	30, 1996'' after ''September 30, 1993'';
10	(3) by adding at the end of subsection (c) the fol-
11	lowing new sentence: "There are authorized to be ap-
12	propriated, out of funds otherwise authorized to be
13	appropriated to the National Science Foundation: (1)
14	\$16,200,000 for engineering research and \$10,900,000
15	for geosciences research for the fiscal year ending Sep-
16	tember 30, 1995, and (2) \$16,686,000 for engineering
17	research and \$11,227,000 for geosciences research for
18	the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996.''; and
19	(4) by adding at the end of subsection (d) the fol-
20	lowing new sentence: "There are authorized to be ap-
21	propriated, out of funds otherwise authorized to be
22	appropriated to the National Institute of Standards
23	and Technology, \$1,900,000 for the fiscal year ending
24	September 30, 1995, and \$1,957,000 for the fiscal
25	year ending September 30, 1996.''.

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1 SEC. 2. EARTHQUAKE ENGINEERING ASSESSMENT.

2 (a) ASSESSMENT.—The President shall conduct an as3 sessment of earthquake engineering research and testing ca4 pabilities in the United States. This assessment shall in5 clude—

6 (1) the need for shake tables and other earth7 quake engineering research and testing facilities in
8 the United States;

9 (2) options to cooperate with other countries that
10 have developed complementary earthquake engineering
11 research and testing programs and facilities;

(3) projected costs for construction, maintenance,
and operation of new earthquake engineering research
and testing facilities in the United States; and

(4) options and recommendations to provide
funding for the construction and operation of new
earthquake engineering and testing facilities, including the feasibility and advisability of developing a
comprehensive earthquake engineering research and
testing program within the scope of the Earthquake
Hazards Reduction Act of 1977.

(b) DEADLINE.—The assessment required by subsection
(a) shall be transmitted to Congress within nine months
after the date of enactment of this Act.

Amend the title so as to read: "An Act to authorize appropriations for carrying out the Earthquake Hazards Reduction Act of 1977 for fiscal years 1995 and 1996.".
