## A BILL

To terminate the gas turbine-modular helium reactor program of the Department of Energy, and to dedicate the savings to deficit reduction.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF GAS TURBINE-MODULAR HE-
- 4 LIUM REACTOR PROGRAM.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the provisions of
- 6 sections 2121 through 2126 of the Energy Policy Act of
- 7 1992 (106 Stat. 3081; 42 U.S.C. 13491 et seq.), the Sec-
- 8 retary of Energy shall take such actions as may be nec-
- 9 essary to terminate, as soon as possible, the gas turbine-

- 1 modular helium reactor program of the Department of
- 2 Energy.
- 3 (b) Transfer of Project Funds to Deficit Re-
- 4 DUCTION FUND.—Of the funds made available under the
- 5 heading "Department of Energy—Energy Supply, Re-
- 6 search and Development Activities" in the Energy and
- 7 Water Development Appropriations Act, 1994 (Public
- 8 Law 103-126), \$12,000,000 shall be transferred to the
- 9 Deficit Reduction Fund established by Executive Order
- 10 12858 (58 Fed. Reg. 42185). Such sum shall be in addi-
- 11 tion to the amounts specified in section 2(b) of such order,
- 12 but shall be subject to the requirements and limitations
- 13 set forth in sections 2(c) and 3 of such order.

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
