Mr. SAXTON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries

A BILL

To conduct a demonstration project which permits traditional wildlife-related uses on lands acquired for the Edwin B. Forsythe Wildlife Refuge until a public use management plan for those lands is adopted.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That for the 5-year period beginning on the date of enact-
4 ment of this Act and notwithstanding the National Wild-
5 life Refuge System Administration Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C.
6 668dd), the Secretary of the Interior shall conduct a dem-
7 onstration project under which the Secretary shall permit
8 the traditional wildlife-related uses, including fishing and

1 hunting, of lands acquired after the date of enactment of
2 this Act for inclusion in the Edwin B. Forsythe Wildlife
3 Refuge until a formal public use management plan for
4 those lands is adopted. At the end of the 5-year period,
5 the Secretary shall submit a report to the Congress on
6 the results of the demonstration project carried out under
7 this Act.
