A BILL

To establish requirements relating to the issuance and review of regulations by Federal agencies.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Regulation
5 Cost-Benefit Assessment Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO**
7 **THE ISSUANCE AND REVIEW OF REGULA-**
8 **TIONS BY FEDERAL AGENCIES.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as otherwise provided in
10 this section, Executive Order 12291 of February 17, 1981,

1 as in effect on that date (in this Act referred to as the
2 “Order”), shall apply to each agency (as that term is de-
3 fined in the Order).

4 (b) EXCEPTIONS.—In the application of the Order—

5 (1) “rules in effect on the date of the enact-
6 ment of the Federal Regulation Cost-Benefit Assess-
7 ment Act of 1993” shall be substituted for “cur-
8 rently effective rules”; and

9 (2) “the date of the enactment of the Federal
10 Regulation Cost-Benefit Assessment Act of 1993”
11 shall be substituted for “the date of this Order”.
