Mrs. ROUKEMA introduced the following bill; which was referred jointly to the
Committees on Post Office and Civil Service and House Administration

A BILL

To eliminate automatic pay adjustments for Members of
Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Congressional Pay
5 Reform Act of 1994”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF AUTOMATIC PAY ADJUSTMENTS.**

7 Section 601(a) of the Legislative Reorganization Act
8 of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 31) is amended to read as follows:

9 “SEC. 601. (a) Until adjusted under section 225 of
10 the Federal Salary Act of 1967 or any other provision of
11 law, the annual rate of pay for—

1 “(1) each Senator, Member of the House of
2 Representatives, and Delegate to the House of Rep-
3 resentatives, and the Resident Commissioner from
4 Puerto Rico,

5 “(2) the President pro tempore of the Senate,
6 the majority leader and the minority leader of the
7 Senate, and the majority leader and the minority
8 leader of the House of Representatives, and

9 “(3) the Speaker of the House of
10 Representatives, shall be the rate payable for each
11 such position as of the date of the enactment of the
12 Congressional Pay Reform Act of 1994.”.
