Mr. INGLIS of South Carolina introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

## A BILL

To repeal the Davis-Bacon Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Davis-Bacon Abolition  
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL.**

7 The Act of March 3, 1931 (40 U.S.C. 276a—276a–  
8 5) (known as the Davis-Bacon Act) is repealed.

9 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

10 The repeal made by section 2 shall take effect 5 days  
11 after the date of the enactment of this Act. Such repeal  
12 shall not affect the validity or continued operation of a
