Mr. INGLIS of South Carolina introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

A BILL

To reduce the Speaker of the House's spending on salaries and expenses.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act shall be cited as the "House Speaker's Staff
5 Reduction Act".

6 **SEC. 2. REDUCE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE'S SPENDING.**

7 The Speaker of the House of Representatives appro-
8 priation for staff salaries and expenses shall be reduced
9 by 20 percent. This reduction shall not be less than
10 \$280,000. A ceiling of \$1,115,000 shall be placed on the

- 1 Speaker's spending for staff salaries and expenses. This
- 2 reduction shall begin in fiscal year 1995.
