

# AMENDMENTS

# In the Senate of the United States,

September 22 (legislative day, September 7), 1993.

*Resolved,* That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 38) entitled "An Act to establish the Jemez National Recreation Area in the State of New Mexico, and for other purposes" do pass with the following

# **AMENDMENTS:**

1 (1)Page 4, line 19, strike out [religious purposes,] and

2 insert: customary uses,

3 (2)Page 4, line 20, strike out [shall,] and insert: *shall*,
4 *subject to the provisions of section 2(n)*

5 (3)Page 4, line 23, strike out [religious purposes,] and
6 insert: *customary uses,*

(4)Page 5, line 2, strike out all after "Act")." down to
and including line 9 and insert: *The Secretary, in accord- ance with such Act, upon request of an Indian tribe or pueblo, may from time to time temporarily close to general public use one or more specific portions of the recreational area in order to protect traditional and customary uses in such portions by Indian peoples.*

14 (5)Page 6, line 7, strike out all after "law." down to15 and including line 15

### 1 **(6)**Page 9, after line 5, insert:

2 (n) RESOURCE PROTECTION.—The Secretary may designate zones where, and establish periods when, any activity 3 otherwise permitted in the recreation area will not be per-4 mitted for reasons of public safety, administration, fish and 5 wildlife management, protection of archaeological or cul-6 7 tural resources, or public use and enjoyment. Except in emergencies such designations by the Secretary shall be put 8 into effect only after consultation with the appropriate 9 State agencies, appropriate tribal leaders, and other af-10 fected parties. 11

## 12 (7)Page 11, after line 13, insert:

### 13 SEC. 5. ACQUISITION OF LAND.

(a) STATE LAND.—Land and interests in land within
the boundaries of the recreation area that are owned by the
State of New Mexico, or a political subdivision of New Mexico, may be acquired only by donation or exchange.

18 (b) OFFERS TO SELL.—

19 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2), the
20 Secretary may acquire land and interests in land
21 within the boundaries of the recreation area by dona22 tion, purchase with donated or appropriated funds, or
23 exchange.

24 (2) LIMITATION.—The Secretary may not ac25 quire lands within the recreation area without the

 consent of the owner thereof unless the Secretary has determined that such lands will be put to a use different from their use as of the date of enactment of this Act and that such new use would be incompatible with the protection of the natural and cultural resources of the recreation area.
