A BILL

To provide certain employee protection benefits for railroad employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.**

4 Section 10901 of title 49, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) in subsection (c)—

7 (A) by redesignating paragraph (2) as

8 paragraph (3); and

1 (B) by inserting after paragraph (1) the
2 following new paragraph:

3 “(2) The Commission shall in any order approving
4 an application under this section require a fair and equi-
5 table arrangement for protection of the interests of rail-
6 road employees who may be affected thereby no less pro-
7 tective of and beneficial to the interests of such employees
8 than those established pursuant to section 11347 of this
9 title.”; and
10 (2) by striking subsection (e).
