A BILL

To set forth the appropriate budgetary treatment of the health reform program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BUDGETARY TREATMENT OF HEALTH REFORM**

4 **PROGRAM.**

5 For purposes of budget scorekeeping by the Office
6 of Management and Budget and the Congressional Budget
7 Office, any proposed change in law (such as those made
8 by the Health Security Act) respecting—

9 (1) any obligation, payroll tax, assessment, pre-
10 mium or fee required of an employer or of any other

1 individual and which is to be paid to a particular en-
2 tity established pursuant to Federal law shall be
3 treated as a Federal receipt; and

4 (2) any related expenditure made by any such
5 entity required pursuant to Federal law shall be
6 treated as a Federal outlay.

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
