A BILL

To designate certain lands in Alaska as wilderness.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Morris K. Udall Wil-5 derness Act of 1993".

6 SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF WILDERNESS AREA.

7 In furtherance of the provisions of the Wilderness 8 Act, an area in Alaska comprising approximately 9 1,556,793 acres, as generally depicted on a map entitled 10 "Arctic Coastal Plain Wilderness—Proposed", dated 11 June, 1986, and available for inspection in the offices of 12 the Secretary of the Interior, is hereby designated as wil-

- 1 derness and, therefore, as a component of the National
- 2 Wilderness Preservation System.
