3 SECTION 1. ROAD REPAIRS.

- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Transportation
- 5 shall make available to the States and the District of Co-
- 6 lumbia \$98,000,000 for road repairs and emergency road
- 7 resurfacing as follows:

1 (b) PERIOD OF AVAILABILITY.—Funds made avail-2 able to a State or the District of Columbia under this sec-3 tion shall remain available until expended, or until Sep-4 tember 30, 1994, whichever occurs first.

5 SEC. 2. RESTRICTIONS.

6 (a) WINTER OF 1993–94 ROAD REPAIRS.—All funds 7 made available to a State or the District of Columbia 8 under this Act shall only be used for road repairs due to 9 the severity of the winter of 1993–94. Such repairs include 10 filling potholes and emergency road resurfacing.

11 (b) LOCAL FUNDING.—Fifty percent of the funds 12 made available to a State under this Act shall either be 13 distributed to counties or other local governmental body 14 by the State for activities described in subsection (a) or 15 used by the State to repair county or local roads. 1 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

2 There is authorized to be appropriated \$98,000,0003 to carry out this Act for fiscal year 1994.

4 SEC. 4. OFFSETTING CUT.

5 Fifteen percent of the amounts appropriated for fis-6 cal year 1994 for travel expenses for officers or employees 7 of any department, agency, or other entity of the executive 8 branch, excluding the Postal Service, Department of De-9 fense, Department of the Treasury, Department of Jus-10 tice, and the Department of Veterans' Affairs, is re-11 scinded.
