To suspend temporarily the duty on the personal effects of participants in, and certain other individuals associated with, the 1994 World Cup Soccer Games, the 1994 World Rowing Championships, the 1995 Special Olympics World Games, the 1996 Summer Olympics, and the 1996 Paralympics.

 shall be free of taxes and fees which may be otherwise
 applicable.

7 (a) GENERAL RULE.—The amendment made by this8 Act applies to articles entered, or withdrawn from ware-

house for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the
 date of the enactment of this Act.

3 (b) RELIQUIDATION.—Notwithstanding section 514 4 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provision of law, upon proper request (which includes sufficient information 5 to identify and locate the entry) filed with the Customs 6 7 Service on or before the date that is 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, any entry, or withdrawal 8 9 from warehouse for consumption, of an article described in heading 9902.98.04 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule 10 of the United States (as added by section 1) that oc-11 curred— 12

(1) after December 31, 1993, and before the
date which is 15 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, and

16 (2) with respect to which there would have been
17 no duty if the amendment made by section 1 applied
18 to such entry or withdrawal,

19 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such amend-20 ment applied to such entry or withdrawal.
