Mr. BILIRAKIS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

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## A BILL

To require that a study be conducted with respect to the medical benefits and services that are available to individuals by virtue of being Members of Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STUDY.**

4 The General Accounting Office shall conduct a study,  
5 the purpose of which shall be to review and evaluate the  
6 medical benefits and services that are available to individ-  
7 uals by virtue of being Members of Congress.

1 **SEC. 2. CONTENT.**

2 The benefits and services studied under this Act shall  
3 include—

4 (1) ambulance services on Capitol Hill;

5 (2) benefits and services available through the  
6 Office of the Attending Physician;

7 (3) use of military hospitals and outpatient clin-  
8 ics; and

9 (4) any other medical benefits or services pro-  
10 vided to Members of Congress solely on the basis of  
11 their status as a Member of Congress.

12 **SEC. 3. REPORT.**

13 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-  
14 ment of this Act, the General Accounting Office shall sub-  
15 mit to Congress a written report setting forth the findings  
16 and conclusions of its study.

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
